If the answer is yes, **we need your projects!** Trust for Oxfordshire's Environment (TOE) and Oxfordshire County Council (OCC), in association with Grundon Waste Management, Viridor Credits and Waste Recycling Group are offering local communities and groups the chance to apply for up to £5,000 to **improve countryside access** in their areas. Here's some examples of what we could and couldn't support;

- ✓ Practical work to create short community linear or circular walks
- ✓ Improvements to create more accessible Rights of Way, trails and green spaces
- ✓ New routes for walkers, cyclists and equestrians to connect local communities and services
- ✓ Access projects involving local youth focused groups and volunteers or groups with a high level of community involvement such as local councils, voluntary organisations and user groups
- ✓ Projects that are achievable within a year of getting funding
- ✓ Projects that meet the aims of TOE's Grant Scheme and OCC's Rights of Way Improvement Plan

- ✗ Work without landowner permission
- ✗ Work that is regular maintenance or part of a public body's statutory duties
- ✗ Work that is already in hand or completed
